Introduction of yourself and your family</b>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>Please provide a brief introduction of yourself, your family and financial circumstances: Your name, age, residential location, information about your family, such as: How many people in your family? What do your parents and siblings do for a living?</li> <li>If married, details about your spouse, including their education qualifications and occupation, as well as your date of marriage</li> </ul>
<b>2. Introduction of your academic history and English level</b>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>Please provide a brief introduction about your academic qualifications, full study history including year of commencement and year of completion and your English test results.</li> </ul>
